

The CAMIC Mutual Leadership Course: November 2023

An interactive online course for existing and emerging leaders from mutual or cooperative insurers who are increasingly:

- Leading others (formally and informally)
- Tackling complex situations
- Collaborating across cultures

CAMIC is delighted to offer its members for the first time the opportunity to:

- Learn the essential frameworks, models & tools that ICMIF members from over 50 countries praise for transforming performance in complex situations;
- Translate the insights into near-term value through 16 discussions in small groups with peers facing similar challenges expressed in different contexts.

Over six two-hour engaging, live, interactive sessions, participants will emerge with new approaches to help you maximize your impact. In particular, you will learn how to overcome three critical challenges when tackling complex problems:

- People are not rational;
- Expertise is important, but no longer sufficient;
- Our behaviour is typically automatic.

Through discussion and reflection, participants will:

- better understand how you see, think and act;
- diagnose the challenges you face, and
- generate a personal plan to translate your insights into a few, key, easy to apply approaches that prior participants from mutual insurers around the globe report being the springboard to delivering impact with confidence.

The CAMIC Mutual Leadership Course will be delivered twice-weekly online via Zoom by Dave Crowther, CEO of Ginger Insights, with a typical session comprising:

- 4 x 15-minute live lectures
- 3 x 10 to 20-minute interactive peer to peer discussions in groups of 2 to 4
